# **Out of Uniform day**

An out of uniform day will be held on Friday 29<sup>th</sup> October. This day has a pyjamas theme. Students who don't wish to wear pyjamas to school may wear a bandanna (we have CANTEEN bandannas for sale at the school for \$4). A gold coin donation will be collected on the day and proceeds will go to the benefit of David Rushton and his family. David is in hospital with a prolonged illness.

The school is also seeking the donation of any DS games that David could have and we are collecting Hamper donations for the family. These donations can be left at the front office.



## Sensible footwear at school

Parents are reminded that shoes for school should be sturdy and be able to protect the feet of students when students are involved in physical activities. There is a tendency for some students to have lightweight footwear with thin soles and this has become a safety issue. We currently have a significant number of cat eye thorns on the playing fields. In considering student safety any student whose footwear is considered by staff to be impractical in respect of foot protection will have to remain under the cola during play times.

### **Disease Outbreak**

There have been two cases of hand, foot and mouth disease in our school playgroup and parents need to be aware of the following:

#### What is hand, foot and mouth disease?

Hand, foot and mouth disease is generally a mild illness and has nothing to do with the animal disease called foot and mouth disease. It mainly occurs in children under 10 years of age but it can also occur in older children and adults.

#### How is hand, foot and mouth disease spread?

Hand, foot and mouth disease is usually spread by person-to-person contact. It is also spread by secretions from the mouth or respiratory system, and by direct contact with the fluid in blisters. It usually takes between three and five days after contact with an infected person before blisters appear. As long as there is fluid in the blisters, they remain infectious. The virus can remain in faeces for several weeks. Children with hand, foot and mouth disease should be excluded from school or childcare facilities until their blisters have dried. The illness should be reported to the director of the childcare centre or school principal.

#### What treatment is available?

Usually no treatment is needed. Paracetamol will relieve fever and discomfort. Do not give children aspirin. If the headache is severe, or if fever persists, consult a doctor.
