On Monday Stage 2 and Stage 3 students participated in an information session with Senior Constable Michael Steele, Liaison Officer from Maitland Police Station, about Cyber Bullying.

A major point made by Constable Steel was that the use of FACEBOOK by children under the age of 13 is a breach of the terms and conditions. Children at Abermain Public School who have a FACEBOOK page are putting in a false date of birth in order to participate in this social networking site.
