#### When you are driving

- Give way to pedestrians if there is any danger of colliding with them.
- Drive at a speed at which you can stop safely before the crossing.
- Give way to a pedestrian who is crossing the road when turning left or right or making a U-turn.
- Always obey 'no stopping' signs.
- Never overtake or pass a vehicle that is stopping or slowing at a crossing.

#### When you are a pedestrian

- You must always use a pedestrian crossing if there is one within 20 metres.
- Cross directly across the road and don't stay on the road any longer than necessary.
- Avoid walking on the road; choose the footpath or nature strip. If the road is the only alternative, face the oncoming traffic and stay as far to the side of the road as possible.

# **INTENSIVE SWIMMING PROGRAM**

Year 2-6 students are eligible to participate in the School Swimming Scheme to be held for 10 consecutive days from Monday 20th November to Friday 1st December 2017 (Week 7 and 8) at Kurri Kurri Aquatic Centre. The program focuses on improving swimming skills, water safety and survival techniques.

All Year 2 students are strongly advised to attend. The first places will be allocated to all Year 2 students who return their permission slips. The remainder of the places will work on a first in first served process as we have a limited amount of places in the program. Any swimming ability is eligible to attend.

# APPLICATION FOR YEAR 7 SELECTIVE HIGH SCHOOL PLACEMENT IN 2019

Selective high schools cater for high achieving academically gifted students who may otherwise be without sufficient classmates at their own academic and social level. These schools help gifted and talented students to learn by grouping them with other gifted and talented students, teaching them in specialised ways and providing educational materials at the appropriate level. If you have a child who will be applying for Year 7 in 2019 and are interested in applying for a government selective high school you must apply online at <a href="https://education.nsw.gov.au/public-schools/selective-high-schools-and-opporunity-classes/year-7">https://education.nsw.gov.au/public-schools/selective-high-schools-and-opporunity-classes/year-7</a>

The application website opens on **Tuesday 10<sup>th</sup> October, 2017** and closes on **Monday 13<sup>th</sup> November, 2017**. All applicants are required to sit the Selective High School Placement Test being held on Thursday 15<sup>th</sup> March, 2018.





# The simp√est woy

...to pack a lunch box.

With the kids back to school for Term 3, here are a few tips to make packing and eating lunches easy for you and your child.

- Allocate a drawer or area of the kitchen where lunch boxes and containers are kept, so you can streamline packing.
- If you get food coming home uneaten, ask your child why, as there might be a simple reason, like it's getting soggy in the lunch box, it takes too long to eat or you are packing a little too much for them.
- Remember to include a fork or spoon when needed.
- Prevent soggy sandwiches pack fillings such as tomato and cucumber slices separately to be added to bread at lunch time, or pat slices dry with paper towel at home before adding to a sandwich.
- For small appetites or younger children, packing smaller serves can help; like cutting sandwiches into quarters and chopping up fruit.
- Open tinned food like corn, baked beans and tuna at home and send in the lunchbox in a plastic container.
   Tins can be hard to open at school and are sharp on little fingers.
