Non-Local Primary School Placement

Parents/Carers may seek to enrol their child in a school that is not within their zone, although this is reliant on space within the school and the reasons for enrolment. First contact should be made with your locally zoned school before any out of zone enquiry can be processed.

Parents/Carers wishing to apply for non-local placement at Abermain Public School in 2018 should complete an "application for non-local application" form which includes reasons for seeking non-local enrolment. This application must be returned to the school before 1st July, 2017 (end of Term 2). Applications will then be reviewed by the non-local placement panel in consultation with the school Principal. Parents/Carers will be informed of the success of their application by 1st September, 2018 (Term 3 – Week 7).
