
Throughout the seven years I have been at Abermain Public School, each day was an adventure and has helped me make a lot of friends and memories that I will forever cherish.

All work will be completed by licensed and accredited removalists, and monitored by occupational hygienists in strict accordance with all applicable legislation, regulations, policies and guidelines.

The material is scheduled to be removed on Monday 6 January 2020 to Sunday 26 January 2020, during the summer break. No lead based dust will be removed during Term 4.

Testing will be completed to ensure the site has been fully remediated. We will keep you informed if further contaminated material is found which requires removal.

The health, safety, and well-being of the school and the local community is our highest priority. Please be assured that the removal of this material will not pose a risk to the local community.
